

GMCS Dress Code 2020-2021

GMCS has required dress regulations for regular school hours. Any departure from the required uniform must be approved by the Administrator on an individual basis. Failure to abide by the uniform code may result in disciplinary action or suspension of students.

- GMCS Polo shirts
 - ROYAL BLUE on Monday and Wednesday
 - RED on Tuesday and Thursday
 - Students in grades 2-12 must keep shirts tucked in
- Slacks, shorts
 - Khaki or navy
 - No shorter than three inches above the knee
 - Slacks may not have cargo pockets
- Skorts, capris, skirts, or jumpers (girls)
 - Khaki or navy
 - No shorter than three inches above the knee
 - Shorts should be worn under jumpers and skirts for elementary P. E. classes and recess.
- Belts
 - Brown or black dress leather belts with no large buckles
 - K4, K5, and 1st grade students are exempt from the policy of wearing belts
- Shoes
 - Non-marking tennis shoes with socks.
 - No Flip-Flops, Crocs, or backless shoes may be worn.
 - No house shoes
 - Students in grades 7-12 may wear loafers or boat shoes during the day, except during athletics.
- Hair, Hats, and Jewelry
 - Girls
 - Neat hair out of the eyes
 - No hats or excessive jewelry
 - Boys
 - Neat hair out of the eyes in a length above the collar
 - No ponytails or man-buns
 - No designs should be cut into hair
 - No facial hair allowed
 - No earrings or jewelry in any other piercings while on campus or school sanctioned events
 - No caps or hats worn in buildings
- Friday dress code
 - GMCS T-shirts may be worn on Friday or either of the school polo shirts
 - Jeans, jean shorts or denim skirts may be worn on Friday
- Other
 - No skin-tight uniforms will be allowed.
 - Turtle necks in school colors under jumpers only
 - No distressed clothing or slacks/jeans with holes may be worn
 - All clothing must be neat, modest, clean, and cover well (must not be too tight or baggy).
 - Students are expected to have clean nails, hair, and bodies
 - Administration prohibits any jewelry, hairstyles, tattoos, or other dress that is deemed disruptive.
